THE PURPOSE OF CELEBRATE LIFE

We believe that God has given every one of us gifts; gifts given not to make us look great, but to, in some way, bring glory to Him. In having Celebrate Life we hope to help students find the gifts they have, develop those talents, and discover how God can use them to build His kingdom. It is also our hope that through Celebrate Life (and other district NYI events) those students will form relationships that will encourage their walk with God and become great bonds for years to come.

It is worth noting that District Celebrate Life is not designed with outreach specifically in mind. Our target students are those who are involved in your youth ministry. While we do want to do well in competition, “well” needs to be defined by our attitude as we compete and the level at which we play, sing, draw, etc. according to the abilities given us.

At the district level, this is the 6th year that we have combined sports day and talent day into one event. Our purpose in doing this is twofold: 1) We want District Celebrate Life to be a great entity in itself, not just a necessary stepping-stone to get to Regionals’, and most importantly, 2) Having a large, overnight event allows us to have services and put more of an overall spiritual emphasis on the event.

HOW CELEBRATE LIFE WORKS

The Nazarene church is set up into regions. In the U.S. each of these are centered around a Nazarene College. We are on the Olivet Region. Regions are further broken down into districts. On the Olivet region there are 11 districts from Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin. We are the Michigan District. Every May Olivet holds a regional competition for students in 7th through 12th grades. **To participate in that event each student must be a part of his/her districts’ event earlier in the year.** So, we invite students from local churches to participate in sports, talent, communications, Bible quizzing, science trivia, and arts and crafts at the district event. For talent, communications, arts and some sports the district event operates like a solo and ensemble contest. Participants receive comments and scores to help them improve for ministry. Team sports, Bible quizzing, and science trivia will have tournaments and tryouts to determine a single district team.

To participate in the district and regional Celebrate Life events students must be an active member of their local NYI and *must be at least 12 years old by the date of the regional event in May and in the 7th grade.*

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

Things you are responsible to know

1. All participating students must be in **7th -12th grades** at the time of Regional Celebrate Life in May. There are no exceptions.
2. Deadline: All forms must be postmarked by **December 2, 2011**. After that, there is a **\$10 late fee** per registration. Late students wishing to participate in the tournaments will NOT be guaranteed a spot. Please be honest and send late fee if you post mark after due date.
3. Students can only participate in **one team sport** at the Regional Celebrate Life. If they try out for more than one at districts, they must be prepared to choose which team they want to compete on.
4. Students are responsible to know what time their events are before they come, if they are planning on coming late or leaving early. This is ESPECIALLY important for Regional Celebrate Life. Music performances can be rescheduled if necessary.
5. The yes/no check for being able to go to Regional Celebrate Life is now very important, as the assumption is no longer that everyone attending Districts is attempting to get to Regional CL.
6. **Big team sports:** (volleyball and basketball) are in a tournament format at Districts.
 - a. Basketball is tryout - based
 - b. Volleyball is 4-on-4 with an optional 5th sub-rotation
 - c. Soccer is tryout- based
 - d. Your students have these options (which they must indicate on the form):
 - i. They can come with a partial or full team (if full, they will need to provide a team name).
 - ii. They can be placed on a team when they come.
 - iii. They can just come to a pre-set tryout time if they can't make it for the whole weekend.
 - (1) Coaches have the right to ask students to come to the tryout if they didn't see enough in the tournament.
 - (2) Students can go to the tryout as well if they didn't feel they showed enough in the tournament.
7. Students must have original music for their vocal entries and instrumentals.
 - a. Vocal entries must be memorized or points will be deducted.
 - b. Instrumentalists *can* use music.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

Things that will be helpful for you to know:

General Issues

1. Early Youth is considered 7-8 grades. Senior Youth is 9-12.
2. Encourage your students to perform their talent in your church services. This helps to accomplish much of the purpose of this event, as well as help them to get ready for Celebrate Life.
3. Students may want to bring extra money for a café area at Kuyper College.
4. **Registration forms should be postmarked by Friday, December 2, 2011. Late forms will not be accepted if postmarked after Thursday, December 19, 2011.**
5. **Meals will be provided for sponsors with a ratio of every 10 students to one sponsor (example: if you bring 1-10 students one sponsor will be paid for, and if you bring 11-20 students 2 sponsors will be paid for). If more sponsors come they will have to pay \$15 for the two Saturday meals. Students & sponsors with wristbands will be the only ones allowed to eat in the cafeteria for meals on Saturday. Parents and other attendees will need to eat off-site.**

Event Questions:

1. If there are no students playing **doubles table tennis** we will take the runners-up from the singles tournaments and put them onto the doubles teams.
2. **Stick ministry** is considered a mime.
3. Any vocal ensemble/band combining instruments and vocals is considered a **Praise Band**. They will play a set of 10-15 minutes. Please make a note of the focal points on the scoring sheet.
4. If your students have a band with an **original song**, we recommend that they enter it as a vocal ensemble or solo with live music.
5. Have sample judges' score sheets available for your teens so they know what to expect when they compete.

HOW TO REGISTER

Each Individual Student:

1. Must pay a **Base Cost of \$38, +\$1** for every event that they're in. Please have them pay your church, and send one church check for your group's registration.
 - a. This cost covers T-Shirt, facility rental, worship services, and two meals at Kuyper College.
 - b. There is a late fee of \$10 for every registration not postmarked by Dec. 2, 2011.
2. Forms should be postmarked to the Celebrate Life leaders **by Friday, Dec. 2, 2011.**
3. **Late forms will not be accepted if not postmarked by Monday, December 19, 2011.**

Group Leader:

1. Each Local Church must compile the information from the individual registration forms onto the Local Church Registration Summary.
2. Keep a copy of all forms for yourself. Send in one envelope:
 - a. Your completed Local Church Registration Summary
 - b. Each Individual Registration Form (make a copy for yourself)
 - c. Sponsor Registration Form (make a copy for yourself)
 - d. One check for the total (\$38/student + \$1 for every event they're in), made out to **Michigan District NYI**

4. **Registrations must be postmarked by Dec. 2, 2011.** All entries postmarked after that will be charged an extra \$10, which must be paid with your registration. Late forms will not be accepted if not postmarked by **December 19, 2011.**
